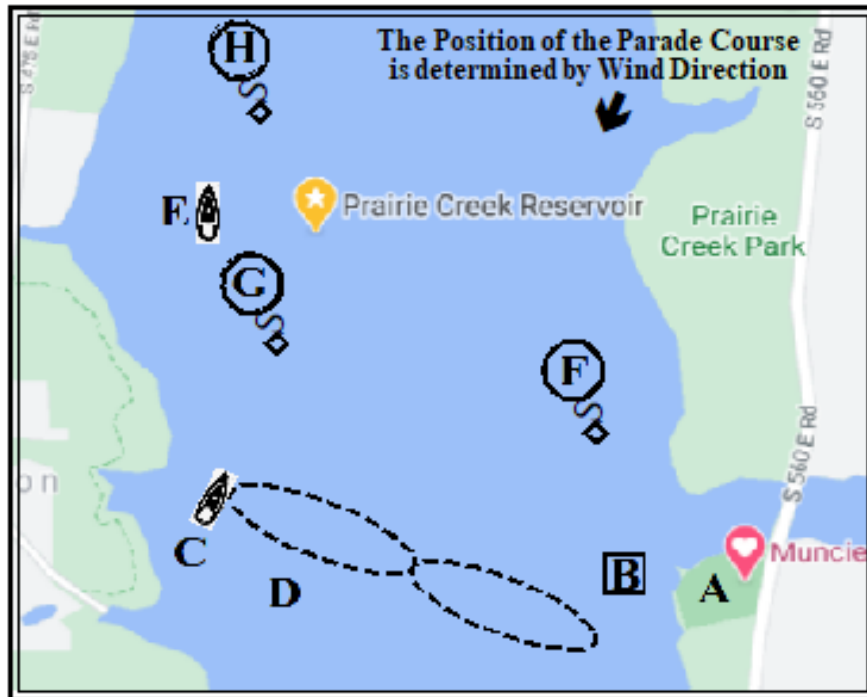


No-Stress, Fun-for-All MSC PARADE-RACE



A. MUNCIE SAILING CLUB

- B. Anchored "OFFICIALS" BARGE/BOAT = Finish "Line"
- C. The "LEADER" BOAT ... Comes-About into the wind at both ends of a figure-8 ("beam-reach") pattern.
- D. Participating boats form a Pre-Race, Follow-the-Leader PARADE.
- E. This "COURSE-MARKING" BOAT Drops the 3 Buoys:
 - F. The BUOY "Closest to the Club" (with a floating Number)
 - G. The "Middle" BUOY (with a floating Number)
 - H. BUOY "Farthest From the Club" (with a floating Number)

UPON THE SIGNAL from the Starter-Gun (horn/whistle/bell), PARTICIPANTS RACE past each of the the 3 buoys - in any order - writing down the NUMBER that is on the Floater beside each Buoy. They Hand-Off this Race Document (with the 3 numbers) to the Officials.

When the crew first receives This Document it is tightly wrapped around a PVC pipe, held in place - beside a golf pencil - by a thick rubber band. Later, they wrap it all together in the same way to have it ready to submit to the Officials (B).
As a racing boat approaches the "finish" barge, an official extends a receiving-bucket to them at the end of a boat hook.

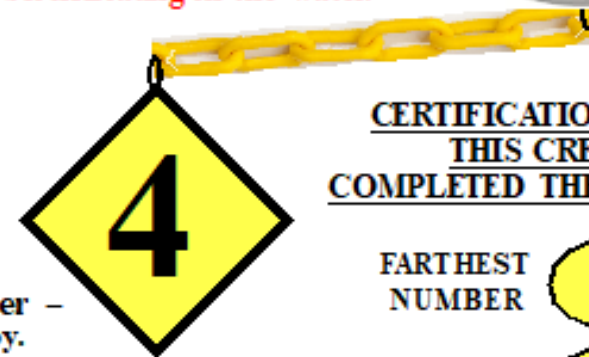
